Roads Commission Meeting
April 7, 2022

Director of Operations Report

- 1) Review of 2022 Paving Bids
 - a. Milestone
 - b. Smith/Robertson Paving
 - c. Wallace Construction

Eric Roberston discussed the importance of milling existing pavement prior to laying new material. The hills and weight of trucks increases the risk of pavement to “slide” or move around.

The Commission discussed ways to reduce the paving bids. If millings are kept locally, it would reduce the trucking cost.

With a budget of \$183,000 it was determined that all drives would not be able to be paved. There was discussion about main roads taking precedence over side drives.

Commission Members Comments

- 1) Mr. Rasdall made a motion to recommend the paving of Sweetwater Dr. and Birch Dr. Mr. Jarrett seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- 2) The Commission directed Mr. Johann to go back to the paving contractor’s and ask if they would be able to complete the paving of Sweetwater Dr. with milling and the paving of Birch Dr. with Birch Dr. residents covering half of the paving costs, for the budgeted amount. The Commission asked if Wallace would provide a bid with milling. The Commission asked if Milestone could reduce the price if millings are kept locally.

As there was no other business before the Commission Mr. Jarrett made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Rasdall seconded. Meeting adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
