

2018 ROADS REPORT

Roads Commission Annual Review:

2018 Projects Completed:

- Crack sealing on Cordry, Centerlake, and Sweetwater Drive as well as Chipmunk, Hackberry, and Eagle Drives
- Patch and repave all of Sunset Drive
- Paved Osprey Drive (formerly gravel road)

Work Completed by Grounds Department:

- Added gravel to the following drives: Birch, Catalpa, Hornbeam, Inkbush, Laurel, Maple, Salmon, Halibut, Flounder, Bass, Aspen, Beaver, Buffalo, Deer, Elk, Fox, Fox Ct, Grey Wolf, Opossum, Raccoon, Robin, Quail, Mockingbird, Meadowlark, Magpie, Kiwi, Loon, Hummingbird, Grouse, Grosbeak, Duck, Bobwhite
- Installed a catch-basin on Elk Drive
- Replaced multiple faded street name signs
- Multiple culvert clean-outs

2019 Projects:

- Repave Sweetwater Drive from Centerlake Rd to Duck Drive
- Repave the following side drives: Badger, Mallard, Grizzly, Lion, Elm, Grizzly Ct, Leopard
- Paint new lines on all main drives
- Meet with Commissioners regarding Wheel tax and other ways the county can help with CSCD road maintenance
- Get all road signs put into our GIS system which will include location, cost, and year installed

Snow Report

- 19 total events in 2018 (16 in early 2018, 3 ice events thus far in this season)
- \$30,350 spent in 2018 for labor and materials on snow/ice removal
- Purchased new Brine maker, spray tank, and (2) pre-wet tanks for liquid applications
- Salt usage should be cut in half as well as labor
- In last 3 events, only 5 hours of overtime despite each event being in the middle of the night due to the capability of pre-treating roads during normal working hours
