Security report read from Mr. McGaha

** Boat Decals are ready for freeholders to purchase. There is a price increase to \$80 for motorized and \$10 for non-motorized motorized. Colors are purple for motorized and non-motorized are light blue Beach passes are also ready for pick up

** Each freeholder must read and sign the 10-point Awareness Questions when purchasing their decals

** Recommend that a Poster of 10-point Awareness Questions be placed at office and at each Marina (these 10 rules are frequently broken and pose a risk to safety on the lake

** Recommended that the ruler that is used to measure the level of the lakes be color coded (Red, Yellow, Green) This will let freeholders know when the lake will be idle or closed to boat traffic due to high water. and the measurements be placed in the operations book. Freeholders should also be aware that the lake can be closed for other things beside high water and watch for alerts from the CSCD office

**Recommended that the CSCD website (under boating decals reflect the length of speed boats rule be posted as written (in the rule book as not to confuse anyone)

An update on the Chapter 3 rule book was discussed with the process coming along.

Seasonal Employees have been hired, Lake Patrol Boats are mechanically ready,

Guidelines for seasonal employees... Respect, Excessive speed while in Patrol boat to a minimum. (patrol at slowest speed when possible) Lake Patrol needs to concentrate on ALL No Wake zones. A lot of complaints come in about speeding in these zones NO WAKE means NO WAKE

Check all passes on beach, Report all gas spills immediately to the office manager, in turn she will notify the CSVFD to determine if spill kit needs to be used.

The Marinas will again be open one week before Memorial Day (this helps fix all bugs from a long winter) before the holiday weekend

New gas pumps are being placed at both Marinas

Speed bumps and the Digital Speed limit sign are used all year and placed in areas of concern. A discussion of placing the speed bumps at the beach area during the summer season was held. This area will be monitored and determined at a later date.
