MEETING NOTES

I. Mr. Hawley summarized his Roads report

II. Discussion of 2019 Budget

- a. Mr. Crimmins discussed frustrations with Brown County getting taxes from the District including the wheel tax for CSCD roads but does nothing to maintain them. This will be an important and on-going conversation with the Commission the rest of the year.

III. Storm water erosion issues

- a. Mr. Hawley voiced frustrations over freeholders demanding the CSCD do something about erosion from the road onto their properties. It was determined by the Commission that freeholder's property, especially those that lie below the road, are to be maintained by the freeholder. The CSCD will continue to be responsible for keeping catch-basins, ditches, and culverts that go under CSCD roads maintained and cleared. The CSCD is not responsible for driveway culverts or keeping ditches on freeholder property frontage cleaned. The Commission agreed that with over 1,400 lots in the District it is not financially sound for the CSCD to be responsible for maintaining freeholder driveways, landscaping, or other parts of freeholder property that erode during storm events. The CSCD will do everything in it's power to stop road erosion and not cause additional erosion issues for residents, but ultimately, a freeholder's property is their own responsibility to maintain.
