### **Director of Finance & Administration Report:**

- the website has all the current boating rules available
- the yellow light is now set for 1 hour before sunset and will be updated monthly, currently 6:23pm
- Deputies worked 159.5 hours in September
- beach shelter house will be winterized first week of November
- boat patrol will be out weekends in October

#### **Old Business:**

- a. Boat patrol body cam review:
  - audio and video was acceptable
  - body camera clipped to life jacket is not secure, will continue to look for a more secure mount so when approaching a boat it will be easy to activate the camera
- **b.** Buoy numbers/tape review:
  - all buoys that had been purchased are on the lakes, 25 new buoys coming this Spring. The request from a freeholder to replace a buoy has been completed.
- c. Budget review:
  - no additions/subtractions have been made, the board will be voting next week
- d. Beach shelter rental policies and fees:
  - 1. the following recommendations were made:
    - 80 person limit/ usage
    - no commercial or business use
    - rental is for the south shelter only and may not be used in conjunction with the special use permit to the renter and/or attendee
    - -no advertising to the general public for any beach shelter event
    - -CSCD, CSLOA and other nonprofits are exempt
  - 2. To finalize recommendations, the security and ecology committees will work together. The number of guests for the special use permit needs to be defined.
  - 3. Mrs. Vavul abstained from voting due to conflict of interest
- e. Personal buoys:

- there are 4 volleyball nets, the commission will develop a plan to remove them
- f. Speed bumps:
  - no new discussion
- g. CSLOA Ox Roast and Fireworks:
  - -security for the event will be provided by CSCD
  - no lifeguard for 1 day event
  - -CSLOA will not advertise outside the conservancy
  - -wrist bands were discussed as a way to manage the attendance
- h. ADA parking:
  - Nick requested a bid for paving, includes 4 spots for parking (2 at each entrance), the area between parking spots is for guest drop off and CSCD parking
