Resolution 2015- 10
Amendment to Resolution 2004-3, Prohibited Watercraft

WHEREAS, the Cordry Sweetwater Conservancy District Board of Directors determined it necessary to adopt additional rules prohibiting the weight and additional accessories designed to enhance the size of wake created by motorized boats, amendment to Resolution 2004-3, Prohibited Watercraft

WHEREAS, the Cordry Sweetwater Conservancy District Board of Directors is an authority to make regulations for the administration of the affairs of the district, in accord To the Indiana Code Section 14, The Conservancy Act, the Board, in order to protect the Conservancy environment and the enjoyment of the property for each freeholder, proclaim the boats...

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that Class one Power or Speed boats:

1. Not exceed 4000 lbs dry weight (as provided by the boat manufacture). The NADA boat database at www.nadaguides.com/boats or manufacture brochure shall become the resource for the CSCD office to determine boat weight, with any disputes to go through the CSCD security commission.
2. Boats that come equipped with wake enhancing devices must have the equipment permanently disabled
 - a. For the boats with internal water storage tanks/bladders, to be considered permanently disabled, the pumps that fill these tanks must be removed from the boat. If the boat uses a common pump (pump for engine and tanks/bladders) then the water line that fills the tanks/bladders must be capped.
 - b. For boats that utilize a "wedge device" to enhance its wake, to be considered permanently disabled, they have the option of either removing the hydraulic pump that powers this system from the boat or removing the wedge itself. Option is up to the boat owner.

Watercraft that was purchased and registered before November 17, 2015 that exceeds 4000lbs dry weight and are continuously registered to the same owner will be permitted to be renewed.

Watercraft that was purchased and registered before November 17, 2015 that has signed the wake enhancing device affidavit stating those devices have been disabled will be

considered permanently disabled devices until which time they are ticketed for using these devices on the CSCD lakes.
