RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 10

RESOLUTION AMENDING A PORTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 2004-3

WHEREAS, the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District (“CSCD”) is an Indiana Conservancy District organized and operated pursuant to I.C.14-33; and,

WHEREAS, the affairs of CSCD are managed by a Board of Directors authorized to exercise general supervision of and make regulations for the administration of the affairs of CSCD; and,

WHEREAS, a part of CSCD’s works of improvement are two (2) large lakes owned by CSCD and made available for use by freeholders of CSCD for water-based recreation, including boating; and,

WHEREAS, CSCD regulates use of the lakes by means of control lights. Resolution No. 2004-3 prohibits boating on the lakes when control lights are RED; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of CSCD believes that it is in the best interests of the freeholders to allow limited boating upon the lakes during RED LIGHT periods by non-motorized watercraft. For the purposes of this Resolution only, non-motorized watercraft shall include only watercraft propelled by human propulsion. Watercraft propelled by gasoline engines, electric motors, wind, or any other form of propulsion except that provided by the watercraft’s occupant or occupants may not utilize the lakes during RED LIGHT periods.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District that:

1. Resolution No. 2004-3 is amended to permit non-motorized watercraft to utilize Cordry and Sweetwater Lakes during RED LIGHT periods. For the purposes of this Resolution only, non-motorized watercraft shall include only watercraft propelled by human propulsion. Watercraft propelled by gasoline engines, electric motors, wind, or any other form of propulsion except that provided by the watercraft’s occupant or occupants may not utilize the lakes during RED LIGHT periods.

2. Resolution No. 2004-3 and any amendments thereto not specifically amended by this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after April 16, 2024.


