DRAFT Roads Commission Meeting May 2, 2024

Mr. Rasdall called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm

1) Freeholder Comments

a. Robin Ct.

Mrs. Flinn shared the history of the road conditions on Robin Ct. over the last 20 years. She expressed her concern with drainage issues and asked for a solution. She discussed the different types of improvements that the CSCD has made over the years. Mr. Vonhoven offered his input that a professional would be able to correct the road but at a certain cost. Mr. Rasdall offered to bring in an expert to look at the road to go over solutions to the drainage issues.

b. Grey Wolf Dr. - pre-paving discussion

There were several freeholders in attendance with questions and concerns about the drainage on Grey Wolf Dr and what the drainage would be like after the road was paved. Mr. Johann met with several project managers from Milestone to go over the concerns of Freeholders in the area of 6784 Grey Wolf Dr. Milestone recommended to grade the road and raise a section of the road to help water to continue to drain and not run off in that particular low spot. Milestone also said they would install asphalt berms around the surface drains to catch the run-off water.

c. 7435 Haw Dr

Mr. Thullen provided an overview of water running down his property. He stated that when new stone was tailgated on the road the run-off problem started.

Mrs. Houston was thankful for the grading that was performed on Catalpa Dr.

Director of Operations Report

- Line Striping was completed and received positive feedback from the community.

- Milestone reduced the overall paving price but roughly \$3,500. These savings will be used to grade Grey Wolf Dr. and install the berms around the surface drains.
